



Inhand Award Scheme Rules

1. All ponies must be Pedigree Ponies registered in the main body of the Shetland Pony Stud Book. Foals must be eligible for registration.
2. The year extends from 1st January to 31st December annually.
3. Cards must be returned by 5th January of the subsequent year - Cards returned after this date WILL NOT BE INCLUDED.
4. Return cards to: **shetlandperformance@hotmail.co.uk** or **Shetland Performance, Arley Cottage, Dowles Road, Bewdley, Worcs, DY12 2EJ**
4. Results must be entered on the card provided. It is the members responsibility to fill in the cards correctly and they will be marked only on this information
5. A separate card must be submitted for each category you are entering. You may enter all categories within the Inhand Scheme for which your pony is eligible.
6. Foals may be shown from 3 weeks at foot as per SPS-BS rules and as weanlings until 31st December.
7. The Awards Scheme is limited to the British Isles.
8. Where show results are not be available online a contact number of the show secretary must be provided for verification
9. Entry fee is £15 per pony. Any subsequent ponies/schemes may be entered at £10 per pony.
10. Coloured Classes - Classes must be affiliated to SPS-BS (designated coloured classes), CHAPS or BSPA .
11. Veteran - Classes must be SPS-BS, SSADL or VHS affiliated
12. Unaffiliated Category - Classes Must be Shetland or M&M Specific
13. Any Scheme members entering our Annual Performance Show will receive a £2 discount per class.
14. The Performance working party will have the final decision where any queries or questions are raised.

Should a member wish to object to the actions of another member of the performance awards, that member should submit the objection in writing within 7 days from the event by email to shetlandperformance@hotmail.co.uk. Should the objection be upheld the offender may be barred from joining the Performance Awards Schemes for the following season.

The Performance Awards working party reserve the right to refuse entry to any of the schemes.
