NPS M&M QUALIFYING ROUNDS : CLASSES TO BE JUDGED UNDER THE RULES OF THE NPS. PONIES MUST BE REGISTERED IN THE MAIN BODY OF THEIR RESPECTIVE M&M STUD BOOKS. PART BREDS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. AT BREED SHOWS NON MEMBERS CAN QUALIFY BUT NEED TO BECOME QUALIFYING OR LIFE MEMBERS TO ENTER THE FINALS. THE HIGHEST PLACED PONY IN EACH CLASS WILL QUALIFY FOR THE FINAL. WHERE A PONY HAS ALREADY QUALIFIED THE PONY STANDING NEXT IN LINE AND HAS NOT ALREADY QUALIFIED RECEIVED THE QUALIFICATION. QUALIFICATION MAY GO NO LOWER THAN 3RD PLACE. **NPS/WTJ INSURANCE BROKERS HOME PRODUCED RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP** – RIDERS OF HOME PRODUCED PONIES (SEE DEFINITION IN NPS RULE BOOK) CAN WEAR A WHITE ARM BAND IN CLASSES WHERE THIS IS INDICATED. THESE PONIES ARE THEN ELIGIBLE TO QUALIFY FOR THE FINAL AT THE NPS SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW.

TSR This show is affiliated to The Showing Register amateur of the year final, taking place at Stoneleigh Park, Warwickshire 29th & 30th November 2025. The highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

CHAPS Both owner and Rider/Exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS nor must the pony be registered with CHAPS to compete. However, in order to qualify both Owner and Rider /Exhibitor need to be a current showing member. Members to apply to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate

EQUIFEST This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at ARENA UK on the 6th – 9th August 2025. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1.** All ponies in Affiliated Classes must be registered with the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society or in the main body of a Daughter Stud Book of their Country of Residence. They must also be in possession of a valid passport relating to them. **ENTIRE MALES AGED 4 YEARS AND OVER MUST HAVE AN "S" NUMBER AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPSBS STALLION ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO 2006 OR THE CURRENT SBSBS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION to enter ANY classes. Ridden stallions must display a stallion bridle badge, In hand stallions 2 yrs old and over MUST display a stallion bridle badge.**
- 2.** If any animal is found to be suffering from any contagious disease, it shall be removed from the showground immediately.
- 3.** The working party of the Shetland Performance Show and T.C.A Trading Ltd, accept no responsibility whatsoever for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall indemnify the organisers against any legal action or claim arising from an accident in connection with this show. British Standard Hats must be worn at all times with chin straps fastened when mounted.
- 4.** The Judges decision is FINAL in ALL cases. The committee reserve the right to change Judges if necessary.
- 5.** In the event of cancellation of the show through causes beyond our control 50% of the entry fee will be retained for expenses.
- 6.** NO BICYCLES OR SCOOTERS TO BE RIDDEN IN THE STABLE AREA, HORSEWALKS OR LORRY PARK.
- 7.** The working party reserve the right to refuse entry without giving reason.
- 8.** Foals must be at least 3 weeks old on the day of the show. Mares with foal at foot may not be ridden or driven.
- 9.** All ridden & driven ponies MUST be 4yrs or over.
- 10.** A novice pony is defined as per schedule in individual classes. NPS qualifier rules apply.
- 11.** All riders ages are as at 1st January of the current year.
- 12.** Young Drivers The Driver must be 10 yrs or over on the first day of the show at which they are to compete. A Driver under the age of 18 must be accompanied in the vehicle by a competent person over the age of 18 (proof of age may be required). When in the vehicle grooms/passengers must have their feet firmly on the floor of the vehicle or use a suitable fixed foot rest. Hard Hat Ruling Anyone under the age of 14 years must wear a secured hard hat when Driving or riding in a horse-drawn Turnout or acting as a groom or handling a horse –drawn turnout. These young driver rules applies at all times and in all areas on the showground.
- 13.** No spurs to be worn in ridden classes.
- 14.** All ponies to be shown in their natural state, only trimming of the beard and levelling of ears permitted.
- 15.** It is the responsibility of the entrants to be ready for classes. The classes will not be held up for latecomers.
- 16.** The working party reserve the right to amalgamate classes at their discretion.
- 17.** THE WORKING PARTY RESERVE THE RIGHT TO RANDOM BLOOD TEST ANY PONY AT THE SHOW.
- 18.** Any objection must be handed to the Secretary, in writing within ten minutes of the alleged incident, accompanied by a £50 deposit, returnable if the objection is upheld.
- 19.** ALL RIDERS AND HANDLERS OF ENTIRE MALES MUST BE AGED 12 YEARS AND 14 YEARS RESPECTIVELY ON 1st JANUARY UNLESS INDIVIDUAL SOCIETY RULES STATE OTHERWISE. Stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker.
- 20.** ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEADS. THIS INCLUDES IN THE LORRY PARK, STABLE AREA AND HORSEWALKS. Please clean up after dogs.
- 21.** Secure temporary stabling is permissible in the lorry park but if the ponies are held in an electric fence enclosure during the day they must be kept in a stable at night or on the lorry. Health & Safety is an important issue and if the working party feels that electric fencing is inappropriate and could place other exhibitors at the Show at risk, it reserves the right to ask an exhibitor to place their pony (ies) in stabling at the showground or on the lorry.
- 22.** If you leave the showground, please leave a contact number on your stable in case of emergencies

23. Leaders of ridden leadrein ponies must be 16 years & over.

FREE STYLE COSTUME DRESSAGE TO MUSIC

(Special award for the best costume.)

The class will be run as a free style to music dressage test in a 20m x 40m arena. With music and costume to match the theme. Music must be between 3 to 4 minutes long and will be timed from opening to closing halt. Entries will be required to demonstrate walk and trot on both reins. More enhanced movements can be used but must be correctly executed and the degree of difficulty will not always gain higher marks.

Lead rein competitors welcome.

- Entries for this class will be limited to 10 and on a first come first served basis.
- Times will be allocated, please ask at the office on arrival to the show.
- Horse attire – Tack and costume must be correctly and safely fitted.
- Rider attire – Any costume may be worn. Hats to current British safety standards must be worn at all times whilst mounted. Costumes, props and helpers incorporated in the performance are at the Competitors' own risk.
- Up to 2 static props and 2 helpers may be incorporated in to your performance. They must only be placed in the arena directly before your performance and removed promptly.
- Scoring – marks will be awarded as follows:
Way of going and harmony between pony and rider. Maximum mark 20
Music. Maximum mark 20
Costume – and suitability to the performance and the pony. Maximum mark 20
Overall performance – considering both presentation and entertainment. Maximum mark 40
In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest overall performance mark will be the winner.
