

Peggy Hampton Young Judges Competition

The aim of the Young Judges Competition is to encourage our younger generation to develop their knowledge and confidence in judging and interview situations.

Method of Judging



Competitors will be required to observe and assess four inhand ponies in a showing class setting. Observations and subsequent placings of each pony to be recorded on their score sheets. Ponies will not be placed in the ring.



In an interview setting each competitor will individually present their ring placings, justifications and observations to the assessing judge. Competitors may refer to the notes they made whilst judging in the ring.



A short questionnaire will cover general welfare, showing rules and etiquette. These will be marked by a separate Shetland Performance representative.

Marking System

A maximum of 120 marks will be awarded as below;

- 40 marks for competitors placing of ponies compared to the assessing judge
- 40 marks for competitor observations & justifiction of placing of ponies
- 15 marks for interview skills, conduct, confidence & presentatin
- 10 marks for dress & physical presentation for a judges appointment
 - 15 questionnaire marks
